Beer duty escalator	Half day in the Chamber on 1 November in Backbench time (Andrew Griffiths and Greg Mulholland)
The Oliver King Foundation – Sudden Adult Death Syndrome	Half day in Westminster Hall on Monday 25 March in Backbench time (Steve Rotheram)
